Organization Overview

Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., founded in 1913, is a private, not-for-profit organization whose purpose is to provide assistance and support through established programs in local communities throughout the world. Since Delta's inception, more than 200,000 women have joined the organization. Currently, there are 1,000 collegiate and alumnae chapters located in the United States, England, Japan (Tokyo and Okinawa), Germany, the Virgin Islands, Bermuda, the Bahamas, Jamaica and the Republic of Korea.

The Tempe Alumnae Chapter, chartered in 1973, servicing Phoenix and the East Valley maintains a membership of 71 educated, professional women committed to transforming lives and influencing communities. Volunteers, who are subject matter experts and operational specialists in their fields, manage the chapter's community programs ensuring that the local youth are prepared for college and beyond.

Our Programs

Funding for our youth programs are through the financial support obtained from donors, sponsorships, and fundraising events. Our organization is committed to service through education and support of the underserved, participation in the establishment of positive public policy and implementation of programs aimed to address local issues in the community. Our internal focus is sisterhood, scholarship, and service and an area our local, community programs align with our overarching organization's Five Point Program Thrust:

- A. **Economic Development**: We hosts Financial Fortitude workshops, a national program of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. designed to help our members and the community realize the overarching goal of personal wealth and financial security through an understanding of basic financial principles.
- B. **Educational Development** Tempe Alumnae implements two youth programs for girls. The Dr. Betty Shabazz Delta Academy is a personal development and academic enrichment program for girls in middle school. The Dr. Jeanne L. Noble Delta GEMS (Growing and Empowering Myself Successfully) Youth Institute is a professional

development and career preparation programs for high school girls. Both programs include an extensive STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) component. For over 40 years, the Chapter has provided scholarships to local students desiring to continue their education.

- C. International Awareness and Involvement We support several corporate Delta projects, including our maternity ward in Kenya, school in Haiti, and home for HIV/AIDS children in Swaziland. Our annual donations to Center of Hope Haiti supports orphans and caregivers. A little closer to home, members of our chapter volunteer with the Welcome to America Project to assist refugees seeking asylum in the Valley.
- D. **Physical and Mental Health** To address the challenges of living holistic and healthy lives, Delta is implementing a national initiative to encourage behavioral lifestyle changes for the physical, mental, and spiritual well-being. *Soul Stoll for Healthy Living* is a major component of the *Journey to Wellness* initiative.
- E. **Political Awareness and Involvement** We serve as advocates for the community through civic engagement on economic, health, and social justice issues. Through our voter registration drives and candidate forums, we also strive to create an informed electorate.
